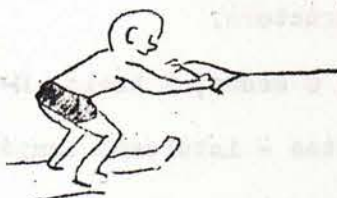
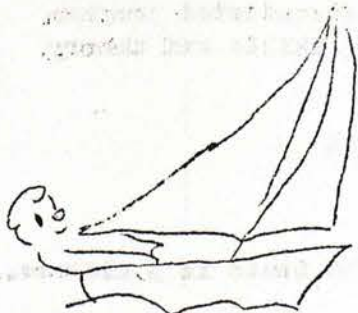
A survey for parents and campers will be mailed out shortly to families who were involved in the 1979 camping season. Your time and help in completing the questionnaire will be greatly appreciated.
