

## Pre Camp Photography

Camp Foley's Photography class gives campers the opportunity to take digital pictures using camp cameras or their own. Camp has 2 to 3 DSLR cameras and 6 point and shoot cameras for camper to use. Campers challenge themselves to try different techniques and critique their work. Campers store their personal photos on a memory card (which they buy at Camp if they don't bring one) and submit 1 to 3 photographs to be used for camps marketing purposes.

2. Create a 3-Day (one hour each) lesson plan that has skill development, photo shooting and critiquing from your research and experience and email it to [alli@campfoley.com](mailto:alli@campfoley.com).

4. Download onto your computer a minimum of 30 pictures that you can use in your lesson plans to develop skills, shows perspective photography, pictures from nature or scenes involving people outside. Internet will not be available.
5. Practice taking different shots if you are unfamiliar with them as you will be the photography experts at camp and should be able to teach a variety of skills.
