## **Pre Camp Swimming Instructor**

## **Swimming Class**

At Foley we follow the guidelines of the Red Cross but are not issuing cards for their levels. This instructor is responsible for instructing various swimming levels, but generally Level 3 (Minnows), Level 4 (Catfish) and Level 5 (Shark). A big difference is that swimming is done in the lake – cold water, wind, waves, cold air are elements that we need to work around. When reviewing your swimming materials it is important to keep this in mind.

- 2. Read through the PDFs on the Session 7 page
  - a. WSI Book
  - b. Swim Chart (be ready to demonstrate the skills in Levels 3 (Minnow), 4 (Catfish), and 5 (Shark)
  - c. Activities
  - d. Drills
  - e. Games
- 3. Send to <u>alli@campfoley.com</u> 3 games or drills that you could play in **each** level to practice or teach a skill in that level be prepared to demonstrate these games, activities or drills.
