Camp Foley's Video Creativity class gives campers the opportunity to write, direct and star in their own videos. Foley uses Final Cut Pro to edit videos

Prior to Camp:

1. If not already familiar, become so with Final Cut Pro as this is the editing system that you will be using while at Camp Foley. Google and research ideas for Video Creativity.
